The Ombudsman Agenda

September 18th: The Portuguese Ombudsman and the State Comptroller and Ombudsman of Israel signed a *Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation*, in Tallinn, Estonia.

September 18th: The Portuguese Ombudsman as the National Human Rights Institution took part in the 27th session of the United Nations Human Rights Council, through a video declaration on the *Report of the Working Group on the Universal Periodic Review* concerning the compliance on the Human Rights international obligations taken by the Portuguese State.

September 30th: The Portuguese Ombudsman and the Higher School of Communication and Media Studies will sign a *Collaboration Protocol*, which fosters the cooperation and coordination between the parties. Its main goal is the promotion of this Organ of State' history and duties, by producing a short film, and equally allowing the Higher School of Communication and Media Studies disseminate its work. This protocol falls within the scope of the 40th Anniversary of the Organ of State, Portuguese Ombudsman that will be celebrated next year.

October 1st: The Portuguese Ombudsman will mark with a small message the *International Day of Older Persons* established by the United Nations Assembly, in 1990, in order to draw attention on the ageing issues. This year the celebration theme is *Leaving No One Behind: promoting a Society for All.*
